1. Council comes early because **the Fall Leadership Conference is October 17-18 in Oxnard.** The theme of the conference is *Lessons Learned*. The theme of the social is Woodstock. We will discuss last minute logistics for the conference at Tuesday's meeting.
2. President Dianne Garcia Stevens has invited **Paul Gothold, director of curriculum and instruction grades 9-12, will report on the progress of the Applied Technology Center (ATC).** The District is in the process of opening multiple pathways programs at all the comprehensive high school and the Mines Ave. and Maple Ave. property in Montebello.
3. Open enrollment for health insurance is the buzz around the District. **Every employee must actively enroll in a plan through CalPERS.** Although open enrollment continues through Halloween, the sooner the paperwork is completed, the sooner the carriers will be notified. The recommendation from the District, CalPERS, and the Association is complete the paperwork this week.
4. The **Board of Education election** is Tuesday, November 3. Three incumbents are endorsed by the Association: Hector Chacon, Ed Chau, and Gerri Guzman. The Council will hear an update on the campaigns.
5. The **NEA RA was held this past July in San Diego.** The report to Council was held over from the September Council meeting. The state and local delegates will report on the national convention. Secretary of Education Arne Duncan addressed over 9,000 delegates at the convention.
6. **Election Chairperson Cathie Reed (JGE)** will report on the result of the September 22 election for Elementary Director and State Council.
