



Second Semester Distance Learning MOU

Significant Changes from First Semester - November 24, 2020

- Establishes distance learning will continue through June 11, 2021 (the end of second semester.)
- Confirms that the employee who engages with the student, marks that student present.
- Clarifies 3-tiered attendance procedure. Teacher required to attempt to contact family 3 times when student is absent 60 percent of the week prior to referral to tier 2.
- Clarifies hotspot or \$125 offset timeline for second semester.
- Confirms document cameras will be available upon request.
- Allows the District to close schools on Mondays and Fridays (or substitute days upon request by principal and Faculty Club Chairperson.) When schools are open, they will remain open for the Board Day.
- Specifies timelines for report cards and parent conferences
- Permits schools to switch schedules for second semester.
 - Secret ballot election by Bargaining Unit members with 60 percent threshold to pass. MTA office can support the election.
 - High Schools may switch to the ATC Block schedule.
 - Principal concurrence to switch.
 - Choice of schedule must be appropriate to school level.
- Clarifies District and Bargaining Unit member responsibilities in reported COVID-19 exposure.
- Allows Bargaining Unit members to volunteer for in-person special education assessments.
 - Assessments are outside the Board Day.
 - Bargaining Unit members will be paid hourly per diem.
 - Bargaining Unit members whose current assignment includes the student to be assessed have the right of first refusal for the voluntary assignment.
