The State Legislature has passed the 2004-2005 budget. The budget includes a much anticipated 2.41% COLA and .9% deficit reduction factor.

The District and the Association will now review how the entire State budget will impact the District.

Bargaining Chairperson Terry SalasOrtiz (CCE) will soon announce the next Bargaining dates for this fall.

Tentative agreements have already been reached on Safety, Security, and General Working Conditions, Highly Qualified Teacher Issues in ESEA, Evaluation Procedures (Goldberg -year Stull MOU), and Early Retirement.

The team has recessed negotiations until after the State budget is adopted. The next sessions will probably not commence until fall.

The meeting hours may be changed through MUSD-MTA Site specific Waivers. In no case are there more than 5 meeting hours per school month.

The Board day is 7 hours and 15 minutes. The standard Board Day is / nours and 13 innitiates. The standard bay is 8 a.m. to 3:15 p.m. Ask your site administrator for the official Board Day at your site.
