The District and the Association are offering an Hours and Assignments training for Bargaining Unit members and administrators interested in learning about this section of the contract. The training will be conducted by MUSD Assistant Superintendent of Personnel Gene Kerr and MTA Executive Director Kathy Kohn.

Beginning July 1, 2006 school sites may choose to utilize up to 2 hours of outside the Board Day time within the Board Day. A complete explanation of this process will be offered at the meeting. The meeting will be from 3:30 - 5 p.m. Up to 1.5 hours of District Salary Credit may be earned for attending this training.

What Happens When Your Site Is Short Substitute Teachers?

Any elementary or intermediate Bargaining Unit member (including counselors, psychologists, nurses, and bilingual facilitators) who is assigned a portion of another Bargaining Unit member's class shall be additionally compensated at his or her per diem rate of pay proportionate to the time involved and students as determined by the principal. For the purposes of this paragraph an occasion is defined as no more than six (6) students for no more than one day or an entire class for no more than one hour. This provision must be utilized on an equitable basis at all levels. This provision cannot be used to supplant the employment of substitutes. (Article IV. Hours and Assignments, Section F.6.)

Additionally, whenever possible, the District will avoid utilizing Support Personnel for substitution assignments. (Article IV. B. Section F.)
