V12 Summer Salary Account:

Camino Federal Credit Union offers a V12 Summer Salary Account which allows you to save for the summer months when you do not receive your regular pay.

Minimum balance and deposit requirements:

You must maintain a minimum average daily balance as disclosed on the Dividend Rate Sheet in your V12 Salary Account to obtain the annual percentage yield (APY) stated on the Dividend Rate Sheet.

Transaction Limitations:

Certain restrictions apply in Camino Federal Credit Union's V12 Salary Account . See branch for details. Early withdrawal penalties may apply. For Montebello Unified School District MTA bargaining unit members participating in the V12 Summer Salary Account program, withdrawals for extenuating circumstances from the V12 Summer Salary Account must be authorized by the Montebello Unified School District. The V12 Summer Salary Account funds will be dispersed twice, half on August 1 and the remaining balance on September 1. Deposits into this account will be restricted to voluntary deposits originated through payroll deduction.
