Apply Now! 2015 CTA Scholarship Applications Are Available

CTA has recently announced that applications are now being accepted for 2015 scholarships for members and their children.

- 1. CTA Scholarships for Members Up to five \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded.
- 2. CTA Scholarships for Dependent Children (includes one Del. A. Weber Scholarship for students attending continuation and alternative education high schools that plan to continue their education in a higher education institution) - Up to thirty-four \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.
- 3. L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship Up to three \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded to Student CTA (SCTA) members.
- 4. <u>Del A. Weber Scholarship</u>—Up to one \$5,000 scholarship for a dependent child attending continuation high school or an alternative education program.

Each scholarship requires a separate application, letters of recommendation and verification of membership. Applicants must request President Lorraine Richards sign each application prior to submission. In order to be eligible for consideration, all forms must be postmarked by Friday, February 6.
