A study from the National Institute for Literacy found that a person who is not at least a modestly skilled reader by the end of third grade is quite unlikely to graduate from high school. Teachers and librarians are literacy experts, so it seems only natural that teachers recommend books for reading. #### **Council Rejects Charter School Petition**

The MTA Representative Council met Tuesday, January 23 and discussed the Charter School Petition presented to the District from Discovery Charter School - Montebello. The petition requests from the District to approve an independent charter school providing an integrated science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics (STEAM) elementary school.

The charter plans to open in the fall of 2018 with about 300 TK through fourth grade students, and plans to grow to serve students through eighth grade.

The Education Code states that the District has sixty days to approve or disapprove the charter petition from the time it was submitted (December 13, 2017). The Board of Education held an Open Hearing January 18 and plans to consider the matter February 1.

Rationale for opposition by Council included that there was no clear evidence of better academic pro-

gress in charters, and the independent charter would have less accountability to the voters. Also, the charter would drain resources from other schools and replicate existing programs.
