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Chromebooks Are Ordered And Will Arrive in June

The District purchased Dell Chromebook 3100 2-in-1 model for students in early education, grades TK-3, and grade 8. The expenditure was \$4.3 million. The new Chromebooks will be available for summer school and the 2020-2021 school year. They will not arrive or be distributed during the current school year.

The Board of Education approved \$1 million for Adult Education. The order will be placed pending the outcome of student and teacher technology surveys.

Summer School Will Be Virtual

The Instructional Division announced at the April 22 Board of Education meeting that summer school will be delivered via distance learning. The Association will send out a survey regarding members' concerns for summer school. Discussions with the District regarding working conditions will begin Tuesday, May 5.
