

A public hearing at the State Board of Education is planned for Thursday, July 9 to consider the establishment of a Charter School under to the oversight of T.I.M.E. Community Charter School, which was denied by the Montebello Unified School District and the Los Angeles County Board of Education. If approved, the charter is planned to operate in the city of Montebello.
