Apply Now! 2021 CTA Scholarship Applications Are Available

CTA has recently announced that applications are now being accepted for 2020 scholarships for members and their children.

1. CTA Scholarships for Members - A maximum of five \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded.
2. CTA Scholarships for Dependent Children (includes one *D. A. Weber Scholarship* for students attending continuation and alternative education high schools that plan to continue their education in a higher education institution) - A maximum of thirty-five \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.
3. L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship - A maximum of three \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded to Student CTA (SCTA) members.
4. Del A. Weber Scholarship—One \$5,000 scholarship for a dependent child attending continuation high school or an alternative education program.

Each scholarship requires a separate application in order to be eligible for consideration. Applications must be postmarked by **Friday, January 29, 2021**. Recommendations are due **Friday, January 17, 2021**. Applications, recommendation forms, and additional information are available at montbelloteachers.org or cta.org/scholarships.

Martin Luther King Memorial Scholarship: *Encouraging Educators, Promoting Growth*

CTA offers the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Scholarship to members and their dependents who are from the following defined ethnic minority groups: African American, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian/Pacific Islander, or Hispanic.

The applicants must be pursuing a college degree or credential for a teaching-related career in public education in an accredited institution of higher learning. Past recipients have received up to \$6000. Applications must be postmarked no later than **Friday, February 12**
