1. This is our last Council meeting prior to the **November 8 Election**. Political Action Chairman Jaime Quintero (FPA) will update the Council on work we have left to do to **pass Proposition 55**.
  - a. Internal Campaign: Executive Committee members have been meeting with Building Reps to confirm that every Bargaining Unit member is aware that Proposition 55 must pass to avoid wide spread layoffs and insure future raises in salary.
  - b. External Campaign: Phone banks have been open since Monday, October 3.
    - i. Most schools have signed up to volunteer. We need the last remaining few to identify a date.
    - ii. Phone banks are open Monday – Thursday from 3 p.m. – 7 p.m. (except Halloween) at the MTA office. Other locations are available if someone would like to volunteer closer to home. Contact Kathy Schlotz for more information.
    - iii. Volunteers are always welcome.
  - c. GOTV: The MTA office will be open Saturday, November 5 from 11 a.m. to 4 p.m. for phone banking and precinct walking.
