1. Please **report your site's 2018-2019 Building Reps** to the MTA office. You may email the information to MTA@montebelloteachers.org or bring it to the meeting.
2. Treasurer Andy Shinn (BGI) presented the first reading on the **2018-2019 Strategic Program Budget** at the May 15 Council Meeting. The budget is available on-line at MontebelloTeachers.org. The Council will **vote to adopt the budget**. The budget includes no increase in MTA dues. A report will also be made on the status of the 2017-2018 budget.
3. Tuesday is the Primary Election. CTA recommends **Tony Thurmond for State Superintendent of Public Instruction** and **Gavin Newson for Governor**. The MTA office will be open for phone banking Saturday, June 1 and Sunday, June 2. Call the office for more information if you are available to volunteer.
4. As the summer heats up, so does the campaign **for Board of Education**. MTA has endorsed three candidates: **Jennifer Gutierrez, Miki Moreno, and Marisol Uribe**. The seats for the November 2018 election are currently held by Ben Cardenas, Hector Chacon, and Lani Cupchoy. Candidate filing is required by August 10 and will be extended to August 15 if no incumbent files.

6. **Bargaining** Chairperson Larry McKiernan (SUI) will report on the progress of negotiations. The two teams are set to meet **twice in June**.
