MEASURE M WILL IMPROVE SCHOOL FACILITIES

The November 2 ballot will include Measure M a \$98 million bond for the Montebello Unified School District. Once passed, the bond will enable the District to secure \$73 million in matching funds.

The bond funds and matching funds will be used to improve schools, including

- Repair and replace aging plumbing systems and drinking fountains to support clean restrooms and drinking water.
- Increase and upgrade electrical capacity and technology infrastructure for safety and better access to technology.
- Upgrade fire alarms
- Remove asbestos and lead paint from buildings
- Upgrade deteriorated heating and air conditioning systems with energy efficient systems.
- Upgrade roadways and entrances and exits to parking lots to enhance safety and security.
- Replace more of the District's portable classrooms with new permanent classrooms.

High School ESEA HOUSSE Meetings Cancelled
