Apply Now! 2010 CTA Scholarship Applications Are Available

CTA has recently announced that applications are now being accepted for 2009 scholarships for members and their children. There are three categories of scholarships.

1. CTA Scholarships for Members - Up to five \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded.
2. CTA Scholarships for Dependent Children (includes one *D. A. Weber Scholarship* for students attending continuation and alternative education high schools that plan to continue their education in a higher education institution) - Up to thirty-six \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.
3. L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship - Up to three \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded to Student CTA members.

Each scholarship requires a separate application, letters of recommendation and verification of membership. **Applicants must request President Dianne GarciaStevens sign each application prior to submission.** In order to be eligible for consideration, all forms must be postmarked by **Friday, February 5**.
