T.I.M.E. Charter School Petition Denied by LACOE Again

The Board of Education denied the T.I.M.E. Charter School (TCS) Petition Wednesday, October 23. This was the second time TCS has submitted a charter petition to the District. The previous petition was denied by both the District and the Los Angeles County Office of Education (LACOE).

TCS appealed the Board's decision at the County level. The LACOE Board supported the MUSD decision to deny the TCS petition at the Tuesday, January 14 meeting.

New state laws regarding charter schools begin July 1, 2020. TCS is attempting to begin the new school before tighter restrictions apply.

Are You Thinking You May Transfer To a Different School Site?

Voluntary Transfers - The deadline for voluntary transfers is **Wednesday, April 15**. Those wishing to volunteer to transfer from one site to another must submit an application to the Human Resources Department. Assignments—Whenever possible, reassignments from one position to another at the same site are announced no later than **Friday, May 15**.

Involuntary Transfers - The District retains the responsibility to determine program needs and to establish the necessary staffing to implement the educational program. Primary consideration for involuntary transfers includes: credentialing requirements, experience in teaching specific subject areas, and teacher in-District seniority. Those Bargaining Unit members that are involuntarily transferred because the current position is eliminated by the District have priority status over those who seek voluntary transfers.
