

Notes from Saturday's Board of Education Meeting



- The Board of Education passed a resolution that gives Superintendent Anthony Martínez authority to take any and all actions necessary to ensure the continuation of public education, and health and safety of the students and personnel in the District.
- The schools are currently closed through Friday, March 27. Dr. Martínez has the authority to continue the closures without additional Board authorization.
- We are working and will continue to be paid. Employees who do not have direct deposit can pick up pay checks in the District Office lobby between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 11:30 p.m. Employees will need to show identification and sign for any check that is picked up. Any checks that are not picked up will be U.S. mailed to the address on file with the District. Bargaining Unit members are paid the first business day of the month. The next pay day is **Wednesday, April 1**.
- The District will serve breakfast and lunch to students. A single package with both breakfast and lunch will be available weekdays between 10:30 a.m. and noon to be consumed at home. Students may get the meals from the closest school to their home regardless of whether or not they attend that school. Transportation will distribute meals to those students who are in wheelchairs upon request.
