Apply Now! 2020 CTA Scholarship Applications Are Available

CTA has recently announced that applications are now being accepted for 2020 scholarships for members and their children.

1. CTA Scholarships for Members - A maximum of five \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded.
2. CTA Scholarships for Dependent Children (includes one *D. A. Weber Scholarship* for students attending continuation and alternative education high schools that plan to continue their education in a higher education institution) - A maximum of thirty-five \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded.
3. L. Gordon Bittle Memorial Scholarship - A maximum of three \$3,000 scholarships will be awarded to Student CTA (SCTA) members.
4. Del A. Weber Scholarship—One \$5,000 scholarship for a dependent child attending continuation high school or an alternative education program.

Each scholarship requires a separate application, letters of recommendation and verification of membership. **Applicants must request President Doug Patzkowski sign each application prior to submission.** In order to be eligible for consideration, all forms must be postmarked by **Friday, January 31**. Also Check Out Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarships

CTA offers the Martin Luther King, Jr. Memorial Scholarship to members and their dependents who are from the following defined ethnic minority groups: African American, American Indian/Alaskan Native, Asian/Pacific Islander, or Hispanic.

The applicants must be pursuing a college degree or credential for a teaching-related career in public education in an accredited institution of higher learning. Past recipients have received up to \$6000. Applications must be postmarked no later than **Friday, February 14**.

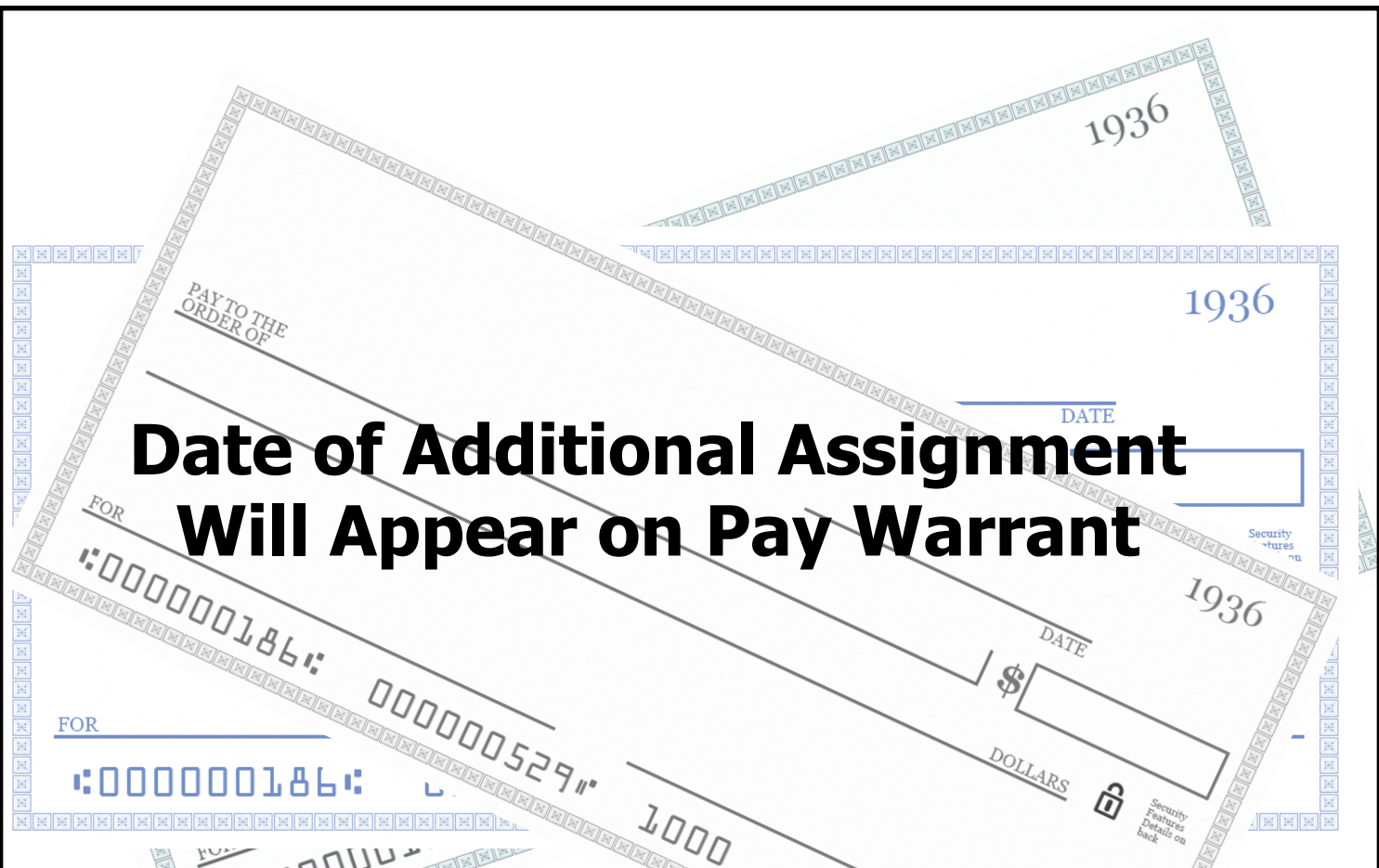

Date of Additional Assignment Will Appear on Pay Warrant

The Revenue and Expense Committee has been working with the District to indicate on the pay warrant which additional assignment is being paid. Often times Bargaining Unit members are due compensation at the \$50 per hour rate for several different occasions.

Similarly, due to a lack of substitutes, Bargaining Unit members are paid hourly per diem for an additional teaching assignment or additional students on multiple occasions.

It has been nearly impossible to discern which assignment one is being paid for since the amount often appears on the pay stub with no additional information.

Beginning Immediately the Date Will Appear

The date for which the Bargaining Unit Member is being paid will now appear on the same line left of the dollar amount. Payroll has agreed to include this information consistently.

For example, if you attended professional learning October 28, your check should indicate 10/28/19 as the end date followed by the rate (\$50 per hour for example) and the units (hours) on the line along with the dollar amount.
