California Department of Education Requires Combined Daily Participation & Weekly Engagement Logs

The guidance from the California Department of Education (CDE) for distance learning requires Combined Daily Participation and Weekly Engagement Logs for students. The logs will be due at 9 a.m. each Monday (or first school day) for the previous week.

The District and the Association amended the current MOU to better specify the obligation of completing the logs and to restructure Fridays to allow for the completion of additional paperwork. The Board of Education is set to vote on the amendments Wednesday, September 2.

Restructured Fridays for Teachers and Students

The restructured Friday schedules will allow time for teachers to complete the logs and students to work asynchronously. The new schedule is planned to begin Friday, September 4.



- Each Friday Head Start and elementary students will check into their class from 8:30 to 9:30 a.m.
- Intermediate and high school students will check into each class between 8:30 and 9:30 a.m. The school administrator shall produce a schedule for students.
- All school/district meetings described in Article IV. Hours and Assignments Sections C 1-2 will be held Fridays and will begin no earlier 9:45 a.m. and end no later than 11:45 a.m. with a limit of 5 hours per instructional month.
- Adult Ed will remain on hourly schedules including Fridays.
