Class Size Bargaining Update 2022

Class Size MOU Ratified & Ready for New Year!

When school starts in August, class sizes will be significantly lower due to a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) ratified by members. 97 percent voted yes to the MOU in today’s tally.

The State Budget is expected to be adopted by July 1. Bargaining will continue with deliberations on Article IV. Hours and Assignments, Article VIII. Class Size, Article XII. Wages, and a new article on Community Schools.



The Bargaining Team spent the last days of school negotiating the 2022-2023 Class Size MOU. The language guarantees smaller classes, tight timelines for exceptions, and payment for overages.
