What's New with Community Schools?

The Community Schools system is built on four pillars: Expanded and Enriched Learning Time, Collaborative Leadership Practices, Active Student and Family Engagement and Integrated Student Supports. The new contract language begins the process of composing a steering committee representing school employees, students, parents, and community partners.

On Wednesday, March 29th, Community Schools Organizing Chairperson Elizabeth Kocharian (BGH) and MTA President David Navar met with the District to discuss the composition of the steering committee. The District and MTA mutually agreed to meet again on April 19th to finalize the steering committee. Further, the District and MTA agreed that the committee should comprise of members from different community partners.
