Seek Approval for Lower Division and Professional Growth Units

Coursework that enhances a Bargaining Unit member's ability or potential to address identified District needs and/or state mandate(s) in the Bargaining Unit member's current assignment will receive salary credit, if approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the District Salary Credit Committee. The course work must be approved and filed, with the required documentation, with the District within sixty (60) days of completion of the coursework. To know more, please view Article XII. Wages Section C.10.b. and c. (page 25).

Pre K-Grade 8 May Say "No" to Covering Students on 4th Occasion

Any Pre K-Grade 8 Bargaining Unit member who is assigned a portion of another Bargaining Unit member's class shall be additionally compensated at his or her per diem per hour rate of pay proportionate to the time and number of the students involved. (Article IV. Hours and Assignments Section F.6. page 5) The Principal can assign students to a Bargaining Unit member without consent three times during the same school year. The principal requires the Bargaining Unit members' consent on the fourth and subsequent occurrences. The prorated per diem per hour rate is the same for incidents 1-3 as it is for incidents 4 and beyond. Keep track of dates you are assigned students when substitute teachers are not available.
