

Catastrophic Leave Bank (CLB) Provides You with Extra Security

ABOUT THE CLB

You receive 12 days of sick leave at the beginning of each school year. Any unused sick leave days are carried over to the next school year as accumulated sick leave.

If you exhaust your accumulated sick leave and you need to remain on medical leave, the district provides you with up to 100 days of difference pay, which is equal to your per diem salary minus \$130 per day.

Upon using up your difference pay, you would be without a salary and benefits unless you are a member of the CLB.

CLB days are donated by members, and MTA distributes them to other CLB members in increments of 20 days if the need arises.
