

Class Size and Caseload Overage Resolution

Between the Montebello Unified School District and the Montebello Teachers Association

December 12, 2022

The Montebello Unified School District and the Montebello Teachers Association signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding Article VIII. Class Size for the 2022-2023 year. As per the MOU, if new students enter the District, the District may exceed class size and caseload caps for 10 days by 1-2 students at the rate(s) negotiated in the agreement.



The following agreement resolves the difference between the allowed class size and caseloads in the MOU and the actual number of students in classes each day.

In cases, as determined by the District and MTA, where the class size or caseload will not be adjusted the District shall provide either:

- 1) additional support to the Bargaining Unit member; or
- 2) additional compensation at the overage rate as listed above for as long as the overages occur.

This resolution is based on unique facts and circumstances, is not intended to be precedent setting, and only applies to class size overages through June 9, 2023.
